At Teknisk Ukeblad Media AS, I did a number of things in accordance with the curriculum, which involved administrative work, service and support, infrastructure and development.

In administrative work, I have been responsible for corporate email systems, managing migration of Office 365 to Google GSuite (the reason for this transition was mainly much better support for certain integrations the company depended on). I reorganized the meeting room culture by setting up booking screens which integrated into our GSuite environment. I also held a few meetings to show how this works. I have had an active role in the management of our telephone subscription, as well as participated in the process of finding a new mobile subscription provider and purchasing on this front.

In service and support, I have mainly helped new employees get started, ordered equipment, set up desks with all the necessary equipment and testing of the system so that employees have a better everyday life. I have provided help and support for meetings and conferences.

Within infrastructure and development I have been working on independent projects. I asked my colleagues in the IT and Development Department about what we use of programs, technologies and equipment to run our websites. After digging and self-learning within what we used at the company, I set up one system of about 20 servers, all linux (Ubuntu 18.04 Bionic Beaver), where I had one pair of web servers, load balancers, file servers, and a database cluster. I think information security is important, so I configured everything to talk over an encrypted mesh network / software defined network .
